SANTA FE CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS is pleased to offer a four-year scholarship to an incoming high school freshman, new to SFC, who embodies the school's mission in academics, personal faith in Jesus Christ and servant leadership. The scholarship provides funding for tuition, books, uniforms, athletic fees and field trips for up to four years.

Criteria

- Available to an Upper School Freshman (9th Grader) who is new to SFC
- Financial need (Smart Aid, an independent needs assessment agency)
- Completed admissions application and accepted to the school
- Average 3.7 GPA in 7th and 8th grades (based on a 4.0 scale)
- Average ISEE scores of 7 or higher in Verbal Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Quantitative Reasoning, and Mathematics Achievement. Strong writing sample. (A separate fee will be charged by the testing company for the ISEE)
- 2 personal references. One from pastor and one from a non-family member. The pastor reference is in addition to the pastoral recommendation in the admission application.

Additional criteria for the finalists:

A personal interview

Any application that is incomplete by the deadline will not be eligible.

EAGLE SCHOLARSHIP FAQs

What is the Santa Fe Christian Schools Eagle Scholarship?

The Eagle Scholarship is awarded to a 9th grader, new to SFC, who has outstanding academics, deep personal faith, strong character and financial need. This is not an athletic scholarship. SFC operates on a non-discriminatory basis, and no one shall be excluded from this scholarship on the basis of race, color or national origin. We do reserve the right to screen applicants on the basis of religious preference.

What does the Eagle Scholarship fund?

The SFC Eagle Scholarship provides funding for tuition, books, uniforms, athletic fees, and field trips for up to four years. Expenses associated with optional mission trips are not included. Scholarships are renewable up to four years provided that a student maintains a 3.7 or greater cumulative grade point average and has continued financial need.

What does the committee evaluate?

- Outstanding academics evidenced by GPA, entrance test scores, essay
- Deep personal faith evidenced by personal testimony, references
- Strong character and leadership evidenced by co-curricular activities, community service, references
- Financial need determined by Smart Aid, independent needs assessment agency

How do I obtain the application?

The SFC Eagle Scholarship application is available on our website at www.sfcs.net.

Deadline: February 1, 2018. Please do not wait for the admissions decision before submitting the scholarship and financial assistance applications.

Is the scholarship for one year or multiple years?

Our expectation is that the scholarship will follow the recipient through all four years of high school. Recipients are eligible to have the scholarship renewed annually based on grades, conduct, involvement in SFC and continuing financial need.

What is the application process?

Submit the admissions application, the Eagle Scholarship application and complete the financial assistance process by February 1, 2018. The winner will be notified mid March.

Can I lose my Santa Fe Christian Schools Scholarship?

Yes, a scholarship may be canceled at any time because of conduct the committee deems contrary to the acceptable academic, citizenship, and spiritual standards.

Will my picture/story be published?

Yes, Santa Fe Christian Schools will use the recipient's image and any related information in publications, press releases, social media, and on our website.
