LOWER SCHOOL
Grades K-5

Excelling on-campus, five days a week, in an all-day small group setting, where students learn and grow through daily face-to-face interaction with teachers.

LOWER SCHOOL STUDENTS need face-to-face interactions with their teachers daily. In addition to learning how to read and write, young children develop social skills by observing, mimicking, and interacting with their peers and adults around them.

In order to maintain the required physical distance, we are reducing class sizes, creating additional learning spaces, and hiring additional staff. Students will rotate between their lead teacher and their assistant teacher. By making these adjustments the Lower School will be on campus five days a week, all day.

Grades 6-12

Excelling in a blended mentorship environment, where students thrive with a combination of in-person and simultaneous virtual instruction. All students will be fully engaged five days a week.

THE ON-CAMPUS COHORT RED/GOLD TRACK is a blended mentorship model maximizing the time students and teachers are together. This model provides the opportunity for all Middle and Upper School students, to be in an on-campus learning environment all day, five days a week if desired. The Upper and Middle School students will be divided into two groups (Red and Gold), with siblings in the same group. The cohort scheduled for virtual-instruction days will have the opportunity to be on-campus to virtually attend their classes using Swivl technology in one of the additional learning spaces on campus.

Each group will alternate days virtually or in-person, all on campus if desired. While the faculty member is teaching the in-person group, the other group will participate in the same class virtually using Swivl technology.
