

THANKSGIVING

We **thank You** from the depths of our hearts for Your presence in our lives. Our hearts are filled with gratitude and we express thankfulness for the peace that only comes from You. Even when things feel difficult, we strive to walk the day with an expression of thanksgiving.

SUPPLICATION

We **supplicate** to You. We humbly reach out and make a request. You said to ask, and the door will be open. We have needs that only You can fill. Help us to live out the spirit of the words in our Statement of Faith, More than doctrine, help us to take Your truths into our hearts and actually live out how we look at You and how we treat everyone around us. Help us to push away the trap of doctrinal self-indulgence. STATEMENT OF FAITH
